**Schedule:**

- 9:00 a.m. Registration and continental breakfast in Willard Athletic Hall. Online registration until 4/16/2008 at [midwestevents.com](http://midwestevents.com). Click on cycling.
- 10:30 a.m. Start of Friendly Metric Century and Cycling Clinic Presentations
- 11:30 a.m. Start of 60K ride with on road cycling clinic applications
- 12:30-1:00 p.m. 100K and 60K riders should arrive in Thorp for food/liquid stop.
- 1:00 p.m. Start from Thorp by those who want to "race" back to Willard (about 19 miles)
- 3:00 p.m. Post race lunch. Award presented to first "racer" back to Willard

**Cycling Clinic:**

- Clinic topics may include instruction on: pack riding, courtesy, drafting techniques, pace line, cornering, hill climbing, sprinting, shifting, recovery, aerodynamics, time trial techniques, nutrition, hydration, training, bicycle equipment/maintenance, and others.
- Experienced racers will give short presentations in the Willard Athletic Hall from 10:30-11:30 a.m.
- Experienced racers will be assigned to small groups made up of those participants who signed up for clinic participation.
- The small groups will experiment on the road with clinic topics during their 60K ride.
- The 60K ride is predominantly flat with some rolling hills.
- Yellow line rule is in affect at all times.
- Stop signs must be observed.
- 60K riders will arrive in Thorp (a food/liquid stop) about the same time as the 100K riders.
- Last 19 miles of the 60K and 100K course can be a race format with no restriction on speed.
- All participants should be back to Willard by 3:00 p.m.

**Friendly Metric Century:**

- The metric century is predominately flat with some rolling hills.
- Historically, the pace of the 100K route runs 20 to 22 mph to the rest stop at Thorp.
- There will be a mandatory food/liquid stop after 25 miles (40K).
- Last 19 miles of the 100K and 60K course can be a race format with no restriction on speed.
- First male & female racer to Willard from the 1:00 p.m. Thorp start will receive an award.
- Yellow line rule in affect at all times.
- Stop signs must be observed except for the last one (intersection of GG & G) before Willard's finish line.
- Sags will be available.
- Finish time for the "race" is about 2:00 p.m. at the Willard Athletic Hall.
- All participants should be back to Willard by 3:00 p.m.
